

Dr H.B.N. Shetty (1932–2021)

It is with deep regret that we record the passing away of H.B.N. Shetty (1932–2021), Executive Trustee of the Malcolm & Elizabeth Adiseshiah Trust.

Hailing from the South Canara district of the then Madras Presidency, Hanehalli Bandimat Narayan Shetty graduated in Chemistry from the Presidency College, Chennai. In 1955 Dr Shetty joined the Madras State Civil Service and, in 1966, was promoted to the IAS. Dr Shetty held many important positions including as Secretary, Department of Education in the Government of Tamilnadu. After his retirement he served on the State Land Tribunal. A PhD in Public Administration (Osmania University) Dr Shetty also acquired a degree in Law. Post-retirement he held many important positions including as independent director of Amrutanjan. Dr Shetty also served with distinction as a trustee of the Madras Institute of Development Studies, founded by Malcolm & Elizabeth Adiseshiah.
